

#### Cleaning tips:

Elimating/controlling mildew in the bathroom:

 Tilex can be carefully sprayed on ceiling and walls to elimate the mildew and wiped off with a soft cloth.

#### Elimating/controlling lime:

- Use lime away on tile or shower surrounds
- Directly put on surface when dry
- Use scrub brush to gently adicate
- Rinse with shower

As a reminder, please help maintain security of all residents by not propping the entrance doors to the building. Reminder: Per the Rental Agreement for each tenant, American Rentals LLC requires a 60-day written notice given from the 1st of the month for move-out.



### **DUMPSTER REMINDERS**

Reminder that garbage needs to be placed INSIDE the dumpsters. Also, please remember to break down your boxes before placing them into the recycling. The dumpster enclosure is monitored and violations are documented. Please contact management if you have any questions or concerns.

#### **PARKING LOT REMINDERS**

All vehicles must be parked in the assigned parking spot in the lot unless told otherwise by management. Please park within the yellow lines. Violations of the parking rules gives management the right to revoke your parking privileges.

All guests must park in the designated visitor parking; no exceptions. This includes dropping off and picking up. Visitor parking is located between the B and C building.

- Hallways are to be kept clear of your personal belongings, including shoes and all other items.
- Patios are for storage of outside items such as furniture, grills (on concrete patios only), bikes, patio boxes, and plants. All other management. Any items left in the lawn or hedges is considered abandoned. Clothes are not permitted to be hung outside using the balcony, hedges, or posts.
  - All items must be placed in each tenants' basement bins.
    Any items left outside of the bins will be considered abandoned.
- Sidewalk chalk is NOT allowed. The use of sidewalk chalk is a violation of the lease.
- Please make sure you are removing your laundry from the laundry rooms in a timely manner.

### Avacado Chicken Salad

#### Ingredients

2 boneless skinless chicken breasts (cooked), cut into bite-sized pieces 2 avocados, cubed 1 small mango, cubed 1 cup grape tomatoes, quartered 1/2 cup fresh or frozen corn 1/4 cup red onion, thinly sliced

For dressing
1/4 cup lime juice
3 tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
2 tbsp freshly chopped cilantro
1 tbsp minced jalapeno
2 tsp honey
Kosher salt
Freshly ground black pepper

#### **Directions**

- 1. Make dressing: In a medium bowl, whisk to combine dressing ingredients and season with salt and pepper
- 2. In a large bowl combine salad ingredients and prepared dressing. Gently toss until salad is coated in dressing, then season to taste with salt and pepper.
