Important Reminders

All money owed to American Rentals LLC is part of rent by law, by the 1st of the month. Rent not paid on the 1st is subject to \$10/day late fees until paid in full. Due to bank policy, starter checks and third-party checks are NOT accepted by American Rentals LLC. Bounced checks are subject to a \$50 bounced check fee.

Reminder: Per the Rental Agreement for each tenant, American Rentals LLC requires a 60-day written notice given from the 1^{st} of the month for move-out.

Dumpster Reminders

Reminder that garbage needs to be placed <u>INSIDE</u> the dumpsters. Also, please remember to break down your boxes before placing them into the recycling. The dumpster enclosure is monitored, and violations are documented. **The dumpster enclosures can only be accessed by your Tenant key fob. To access the dumpsters simply touch key fob up to box and open door (just like hallway doors). To exit, push the EXIT button on the lefthand side of the door and push door open. For any questions contact management.**

Parking lot reminders

All vehicles must be parked in the assigned parking spot in the lot. Please park within the yellow lines. Violations of the parking rules gives management the right to revoke your parking privileges. Any non-working vehicles will be towed by J&J towing unless approved by management. **All visitors must park on the street!**

Other Reminders

Hallways are to be kept clear of your personal belongings, including shoes and all other items.

Patios are for storage of outside items such as furniture, grills, bikes, patio boxes, and plants. Any items left in the lawn or hedges is considered abandoned. Clothes are not permitted to be hung outside using the balcony, hedges, or posts.

Please make sure you are removing your laundry from the laundry rooms in a timely manner.

Crock Pot Ham

Ingredients

- 2-7 lb ham boneless or bone-in
- 1 20- oz can sliced pineapple
- 1/3 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 tsp ground cloves

Instructions

How to Cook your Ham in the Crock Pot

- 1. Place ham in the crock pot. Ham from grocery stores is pre-cooked, so if your ham doesn't fit, simply cut a portion off and refrigerate it or freeze it for later use.
- 2. Open the can of sliced pineapple and drain the juice out into a separate bowl. You will use all of the juice! Measure out your 1/3 cup of brown sugar and add it to the pineapple juice, whisking to dissolve. Add in the 1/2 tsp of ground cloves and whisk to combine.
- 3. Arrange the slices of pineapple all over the surface of your ham and in between slices. Place candied cherries inside the pineapple. Pour the pineapple juice mixture on top.
- 4. Replace the lid on the crock pot and cook on LOW for 3-5 hours. I had about 7-lbs of my 10lb ham in the crock pot and I cooked mine for 4 hours. It was super moist and had a sweet flavor. Bone-In hams will take 5-6 hours to fully heat up. If you have a smaller, 2-4 lb ham, aim for 2 hours of cooking time.
